CHANGES TO MICHIGAN AUTO NO-FAULT INSURANCE LAW

Effective with policies renewed after July 1, individuals will no longer be required to carry unlimited personal injury protections. Practices need to be diligent with regards to discussing this with their patients. Please mark if the service is auto related or not. Please make sure to send the following information to us and also include the date of the accident to PPR with your billing.

- Does the patient have more than one insurance carrier?
- Is the injury the result of an auto accident?
- Does the medical coverage have restrictions regarding accident related claims or is it listed as secondary coverage only?
